Meeting was convened at 5:30 PM.

In attendance were President Thomas Tolliver, Trustee Ronald Allen, Sr., Trustee James Crawford, Trustee Charlie Reed, District Clerk Stephanie Howard, Trustee-Elect Moneik Hatcher, Election Chairperson Rutha Bush, Trustee Candidate Lynelle Jarmond, and Trustee Candidate Joval Nance.

Lisa Hutchinson, Esq., General Counsel, stated the purpose of the meeting, which was to consider the affidavit ballots submitted at the 2015 Annual Budget Vote and School Board Election, which was held on May 19, 2015.

District Clerk Stephanie Howard explained that there were three affidavit ballots submitted at the 2015 Annual Budget Vote and School Board Election on May 19, 2015. The three voters signed sworn affidavits that they were registered to vote in the Wyandanch District. According to Education Law §2019, paper ballots of voters for whom no registration is found on the District or Board of Elections lists must be rejected. Certification of Registration for the three voters was obtained from the Suffolk County Board of Elections, copies of which were exhibited to all in attendance, and it was determined that none of the three voters were registered to vote in the Wyandanch District. Therefore, the three affidavit ballots were rejected, and the results of the 2015 Annual Budget Vote and School Board Election were unaffected.

Ms. Hutchinson asked if there were any questions. Chairperson Bush asked to make a comment. She stated that it was a waste of time to come out to address this issue, because as part of her duties as Chairperson of the election, she had already contacted the Board of Elections regarding voter qualification, and was given the same information on the day of the elections. She prided herself in doing a thorough job.

The District Clerk asked the Board of Education if they would like to certify the results of the election at that time, but Trustee Reed suggested that they wait until the entire Board could be present to discuss.

The meeting was concluded at 6:00 PM.
