

BUDGET HEARING

Mr. Bob Howard started the Budget Presentation at 7:15 PM.

Discussed were: 2015-16 Budget Highlights: Maintains all Programs - Instructional and Extracurricular; Program Enhancements - Social, Emotional and Mental, ELA & Math, Summer School, Modification of Oasis program, Class sizes reduction, New Pathways/electives, Increased Bilingual Staff, Band, Inclusion, All Day Pre-K, Community Eligibility Provision; Difference between the 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 Budgets; Explanation of 3-Part Budget and Revenue By Source; Budget and Tax Levy History; Contingency Budget; Tax Impact to Average Homeowner; Property Tax Rebate year 2; Upcoming Budget Vote on May 19, 2015 in the Central Administration Building Board Room.

BUS #2 Government Efficiency Plan Resolution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Wyandanch Union Free School District is desirous of participating with other Western Suffolk BOCES component districts in submitting a government efficiency plan. WUFSD's planned contribution to government efficiencies would include savings of over two million dollars (\$2,000,000) per year. These savings will be realized a result of switching from a self-insured employee health plan to the New York State Health Insurance Plan (NYSHIP).

RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education designates the Cold Spring Harbor School District as lead entity for purposes of submission of the Government Efficiency Plan on behalf of the Wyandanch Union Free School District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education authorizes the superintendent and the chief financial officer to certify the submission of the Government Efficiency Plan on behalf of the Wyandanch Union Free School District and provide to the Cold Spring Harbor School District as the lead entity.
