BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

R.S. Abrams & Co., LLP presented to the Audit Committee the results of the firm's external audit of the District's Financial Statements for 2017-18, and the associated Management Letter.

The Audit Committee approved the following two resolutions at their meeting on October 10, 2018 to permit the District to file the Financial Statements for 2017-18 and the associated Management Letter on or before October 15, 2018 (with automatic 30-day statutory extension as required by state law.
