National Nutrition Month's theme this year is "Beyond the Table." Created by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, the theme addresses all aspects of food, from its production and distribution, grocery stores and farmers' markets, to the table, at schools, restaurants and home.

WUFSD Food Service Manager Ms. Coreas is exploring ways to improve the school food environment, including increasing participation in the breakfast and lunch meal program (which is free) as well as the availability of approved healthy snacks (Smart Snacks) sold during the day. These are not easy tasks and she will be partnering with Ms. Alvarez and the Leaders of the Future (LOTF) to solicit students' opinions and food preferences. In addition, Ms. Coreas and Director of Athletics, Health and PE, Mr. Davis, will be updating the District's Wellness Policy. 
